* Please make arrangements early to have your child at practice. There is only ONE practice for each group. May we suggest that you pick your child up at school or arrange carpooling so that everyone is on time. Early dismissal from school for Communion Practice is an acceptable excuse. Please also remember to give your child a snack before practice. At the end of practice, children MUST be picked-up in the Church. Thank you.

Thursday, January 31, 2019 at 7:00 pm - Group 2 Children whose last name begins L through Z

Please arrive by 6:45 PM to pick up your child's certificate envelope in the St. John Neumann room. The children will all sit together and their family and friends will be seated in the remainder of the available pews.

There will be NO seating in pews where confessions are being heard. We are fortunate to have 8-10 priests available to hear Confessions.

The children will be invited to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation first, and then all family members are encouraged to receive this Sacrament of God's love and forgiveness as well. Thank you.

Saturday, May 4, 2019 children receive First Holy Communion

9:30a.m. Mass: GROUP 1 - Children whose last name begins A through K

Children should arrive at the Daily Mass Chapel by 9:00 a.m. Parents, family and friends may go directly to the Church.

12:00 noon Mass: GROUP 2 - Children whose last name begins L through Z

Children should arrive at the Daily Mass Chapel by 11:30 a.m. Parents, family and friends may go directly to the Church.

tie (any color)
suit or sport jacket
dress slacks
dress shoes

Girls: white dress
white socks or tights
white dress shoes

optional: veil

NO sneakers, gloves, rosaries, jewelry, purses or flowers, please!
